Teaching and Learning Team Update

District Service

- 1. The team has provided 80 days of professional development, including preparation and follow up, to Crestline, Galion, Lucas, and Northmor, with 64 days left.
- 2. Currently, we are scheduled to provide 7 sessions of PD to non-public schools, amounting to roughly 10 days of presentation, preparation, and follow up time.
- 3. I am meeting with the administrative teams in our four districts to review professional development to date and explain our recommendations for the rest of the school year and into the fall.
- 4. On February 7, the team met to complete monitoring tools customized for each district to measure teacher fidelity (walk-throughs, observations, surveys, etc.) and impact on student learning. The team is also working on information for the T&L brochure.
- 5. The team is providing all-day professional development for Madison's inservice day on February 14.
- 6. Carrie Wood and I are participating in ODE's literacy trainings, which are providing critical information for delivering professional development for ELA in PreK 12.

Networking Meetings

February 14 is the next Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment network meeting. The topics will include the latest updates on literacy from ODE, the science of reading, brief information on new Graduation Requirements, and discussion of using Item Analysis to track instruction of the various strands in Ohio's Math Standards. The final meeting will be April 24.

Other Projects

I collaborated with Jennifer Crum to present information on standards-based IEP goals and objectives at her training "The Essential IEP" on January 15, 2020. This opportunity provided a base for future assistance to intervention specialists regarding their instructional and assessment practices.
