3. CUSTOMER'S OBLIGATIONS

- a. Customer shall provide Provider with appropriate and sufficient space and electrical power to facilitate the installation and operation of the Internet Access.
- b. Customer shall provide surge suppression for all devices either directly or indirectly connected to the Internet via the Internet Access.
- c. Customer shall not connect any of its LANs to alternative Internet Access providers without the written prior approval of Provider.
