Teaching and Learning

- 1. The team's final meeting was June 10
 - a. The group welcomed three new members: Heather Dillon (literacy), Rebecca Kidney (math), and Danya Davis (literacy).
 - b. At the meeting, the team finished compiling all work done for T&L contracted districts in 2021 – 2022. The new Director, Carrie Wood, will easily be able to reference accomplished goals and projects.
 - c. Consultants worked with me to create tentative district assignments for next school year; Carrie Wood and I will finalize these in July.
- 2. I will be mentoring Lucas' new curriculum/special education coordinator, Kaitlyn Fraley, beginning June 20 and continuing for up to 18 days. Carrie Wood will also help with this process by providing literacy information to bring Kaitlyn up to speed on the science of reading.
- 3. We had 20 participants for a Wilson Language Introductory Course training June 7-9 and will have a profit of approximately \$800.
- 4. Orton-Gillingham training is set up for late July and early August; we currently have 18 participants and may see a profit of \$3,000 or more depending on the final number of participants.

Comprehensive Literacy State Development Grant

1. The CLSD grant team wrapped up the year by meeting with leadership from both model sites on June 3. They decided next steps based on data and stakeholders' feedback from this school year. The grant will have a solid foundation for the fall to accomplish the required tasks as outlined in the grant application.

- 2. Kelly Britton was a half-time CLSD coach this year and did expert work in data gathering and analysis, leading teacher groups, training administrators, and coaching teachers in structured literacy. She has accepted a position as the Director of Teaching and Learning at Lorain County ESC, and she'll be greatly missed.
- 3. Kalin Wilburn will join the CLSD team to take on many of the roles that Kelly accomplished this year. We welcome her to the team.

Gifted Team

The team members have finished their contracts for the year. Before leaving, they set up final details for their session presentations at the Administrative Conference on August 1; they also completing plans for the August 9 gifted workshop here at Mid-Ohio on technology skills for gifted education.
