Art is Therapy, tapping into your creative side can do more for your mind and health than you may think. In fact, when you get creative through art therapy, you give yourself the opportunity to heal from a variety of conditions. Abraxas Art provides therapy for students who have experienced trauma, lost a loved one, have severe anxiety, or have had other experiences or conditions that impact their daily lives in some way. This class helps students share their emotions and communicate in a way that's not overwhelming. This class helps students understand art as a therapy, how it works for various people and conditions, this can be done for an individual, a loved one, or a part of an organization. Students will complete various activities such as masks, bracelets, acrylic painting/ pouring, water color, clay, and various other projects that represent internal emotions from physical, emotional, and mental trauma.

How will your students benefit from this project / program? *

The students will benefit socially and emotionally in many ways such as: Decrease depression, reduce trauma based stress, improve ability to cope with trauma, stimilate mental dysfunction from trauma. The purpose of the activities encourage students to recognize that they are part of an international learning community.

What kind of measurable outcomes will be tracked to determine the success of the program? *

The trauma that are students have experienced leads to increased negative behaviors. Therefore, once the students have completed the program the students should exhibit more positive behaviors which will be documented daily. Upon successful completion of this program students should be able to demonstrate ability to communicate and express their emotions effectively through various forms of art. Students will learn new creative skills.
