- The long-awaited Dyslexia Modules have been released! Our literacy consultants are serving in 9 districts (underlined) to facilitate this important professional development compliance work related to law and guidance. Our expert literacy team is ready to begin facilitating the modules this week and will continue through May.
- We continue to get more requests wanting not just elementary support, but specific content area support in grades 6-12. As part of that response, we hosted our first adolescent coaching network with four pilot schools in collaboration with Dr. Burke's department, T& L department and the AL ODE coach. School leaders and their core content leaders spent a full day learning about how to leverage literacy to help students learn their content.
- Our literacy team continues to participate in extensive training related to Ohio's dyslexia law and Ohio's initiatives.
- T&L Team Meeting: Team Lead audited district days/work; Leaders were updated quarterly status and reviewed work plans. Consultants continue to use tracker, calendar, report summary to principals after each visit and update plans with leaders
- Curriculum Instruction and Assessment Network -November 11, @ MOESC will feature an ODE expert on the new Early literacy rating system on the state report card. Rachel Wakefield from the Office of Assessment will assist leaders in thinking strategically to their response in evaluating their reading model during our meeting.

- The gifted consultants are all finishing some Written Education Plans for **newly identified students** for service (WEPS). This is an especially busy time for the team in helping educators prepare for conferences and updating the data bases/reporting.
- ODE had an "invite only" session to provide feedback for the new proposed changes with the gifted "rule" (Ohio's gifted statutes)
- District Gifted Reports were sent to leadership outlining gifted work since August and next steps
- In addition, district leaders need our consultant's assistance with the new reporting of gifted on the state report card. The team is preparing a report card resource to assist leaders along with their customized guidance in strategically planning for the model in each of their school districts. The new representation component is something all leaders are wanting to improve as they look at reaching unrepresented populations.
- The team and I attended OAGC Fall conference in Columbus, Ohio. Very informational in helping the team prepare districts in responding to the new gifted component.
- Leanna Ferreira, MOESC gifted lead and OAGC rep, presented with a full room at the conference! Well done!

AL and CLSD grant work:

- CLSD's Lisa Cook and Kalin Wilburn are busy with Science of Reading, PBL w/STEM and assisting with dyslexia training
- Lisa and Kalin are publishing a newsletter called "Literacy Liftoff" to provide timely resources and learning on the science of reading topics.
- As mentioned above, Universal support provided by the new ODE Adolescent Literacy position are potentially being piloted with 4 of our district clients in an Adolescent Literacy 6-12 Network. Amber Clay-Mowry, Dr. Burke and I will be facilitating the network through May
- Amber returned from the Reading League Conference (as well as T&L Danya Davis) critical resources were brought back to share
- The Structured Literacy and Adolescent Grant quarterly reports were received and reported "well done" by ODE's grant administrator, Katie Dean.
