- Swapped out toilet fixtures at the preschool at their request. The automated flushers were scaring the kiddos.
- Johnson Controls has determined the cause of our fire panel issues. We will need to replace the main fire panel and two actuators(est. costs \$15,500).
- Received the new lettering for our 4-silver wall mounted directional signage and will be mounting the letters soon.
- Newly initiated system for cleaning the conference center kitchen and café area. The café has experienced a significant increase in the use of food service and eating requiring a different cleaning procedure.
- Garland Roofing has received the bids for the final stage of the roof restoration project. Once again, Alumni Roofing was the lowest responsible bidder. The plan is to restore the final 4 Bands during this final stage later this summer or early fall, pending Board approval. Three bands were restored in each of the first two phases.
