## Board Report September 2025 Leadership & Learning

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### Gifted, Literacy, and Math

- Districts received customized scope of work outlines for gifted, literacy, and math support to guide services in each district. Service summaries, aligned to the scope of work, are sent weekly for districts receiving literacy and math support and monthly for districts receiving gifted support. These summaries provide communication to district stakeholders, monitor progress, and create opportunities for feedback.
- Gifted consultants are guiding districts to ensure service for students with gifted identification. Additionally, they are meeting with teachers and seeking parent input for the development of Written Education Plans that build on student strengths and are aligned to Ohio's Learning Standards.
- September marks the start of the Adolescent Literacy Network. On September 18, participating schools are bringing teams of teachers and leaders together to learn, collaborate, and set building and team goals to advance student success through effective literacy practices.
- We are excited to announce the launch of a new K–3 Literacy Network, created in response to district requests! This network brings together teams of teachers and leaders who will collaborate, share ideas, and build their expertise in practices that strengthen literacy development in the early grades.

### Grants & Other Supports:

- On September 12, the Leadership & Learning and Student Services Departments collaborated to host a networking event for district stakeholders. This joint effort advances the goals of both departments by aligning initiatives and ensuring integrated supports for schools.
