



At-a-Glance

- Administrative mid-year evaluations completed.
- Budget revisions completed for Adult Education and 21st CCLC.
- Funding and compliance watch items: WIOA Title II level-funding discussed for state FY27 (federal appropriation pending); 21st CCLC no new FY27 grant round anticipated; ODEW discussing tighter SSID/EMIS attendance linkage.

Mid-Ohio Adult Education (Aspire/WIOA)

- Space planning: exploring a hybrid model (MOESC offices + leased classroom space); GOAL option under review.
- ODHE update (1/20/26): conference version shows level funding for WIOA Title II in state FY27; appropriation still moving through Congress.

21st CCLC

- State conference: 2/26-2/27 in Columbus
- FY27: no new grant round anticipated; continuation process expected March/April (details after February conference).
- Program planning: exploring Galion HS Monday programming using 21st CCLC funds to support career readiness (pending partner capacity).

Business Advisory Council & CPSN

- CPSN alignment sessions underway: ODEW (with McKinsey) aligning resources to Ohio's Career Connections Framework; local feedback representatives identified.
- Upcoming BAC/CPSN meetings: 2/25 (in-person), 3/23 1:00 p.m. (virtual), 4/22 (in-person), 5/18 1:00 p.m. (virtual), 6/22 1:00 p.m. (virtual).
- Morrow County: TurboCert positive feedback from school counselors/curriculum directors; focus groups underway (education partners completed; results shared at March MWA meeting).
- MTC/Ashland: billing and instructional service agreements being updated to match actual student counts and instructional hours.
- Crawford County: transition planning for Chris Copper's retirement; Dr. Diab site visit planned to view program impact while students are active.
- Clinical placements (phlebotomy): Avita expanded placement sites (Bucyrus and Galion) and streamlined scheduling to support completion of clinical requirements.
