Gifted, Literacy, and Math

- With over 230 registrations from across Ohio, including three colleges and universities, MOESC planned and hosted The Reading League Ohio Literacy Symposium. The event also brought educators from Indiana and Pennsylvania. Educators were invited to help create a large TRL logo with dedications to individuals who positively impacted their lives.
- Mid-Ohio ESC has been asked to share the success of this event with the national TRL organization. TRL Ohio has selected to continue the partnership with MOESC and scheduled May 13th, 2027 for the second annual event.



- L&L team is actively meeting and planning with new districts in Knox County to prepare for a successful launch of gifted services in the Fall. Consultants are also working in the summer to review existing documents, prepare, and plan on behalf of these districts during the transition.
