Transition Planning

Meetings with Casie Grau continue to support her new role at Mid Ohio ESC starting August 1st. This month we focused on the Business Advisory Council “Plan” for 26-27, making connections to our workforce development partners in each county, and meetings with TurboCert Coordinators. Currently, we are also working through higher education partnerships with Marion Technical College and Ohio State University at Marion, specifically for an advanced manufacturing instructor, space at the Miller Center in Cardington, and parent engagement strategies at the request of some Morrow County schools. The Career Pathways Support Network and related tasks are also part of our work in July.

Bucyrus City Schools District Specific Work

Transition planning meetings continue with the administration at Bucyrus City Schools. Planning administrative meetings in content and structure, professional development and partnerships continues to be the focus of our work. Tours of the labs, meetings with higher education and business partners and United Way interviews are also taking place. We are exploring a new credentials program for the 26-27 school year and a registered pre-apprenticeship program in the trades for the 27-28 school year.
